Martha Leach

Q. So, two-under!

Martha Leach: Yes, two-under and it was a good finish. It was a tap in for birdie so that was even better. I like the greens here. I was putting them well on the front-nine. Every right to left, I just saw a line and I was making them. I played well. I shot -4 and then I hit a hiccup on number 10. It was a bad swing and bad judgement. I hit it left of the green. You don't want to short size yourself on a Donald Ross course. That's what I did. A bogey is good, but I tried to be cute and paid for it.

Q: Do you like the golf course and the setup?

Martha Leach: Oh the golf course is a great golf course. It was a little windy today on certain holes. It's just going to be a great test for us this week.

Q: You played with two players who also played well?

Martha Leach: Yes! We were laughing with the group in front of us. They said, you need to keep up. I said we would have been finished already if they weren't there. Everyone was making great pace today. Hit it and go. I enjoyed playing with Mary Ann and Corey. We're all friends so we had a good time.

Q: Do you care about taking this title?

Martha Leach: It would be nice, but it's ok. Whatever happens, I just need to play and get confidence. Each day I'll play and get a little better.
