Q. You had quite a finish, going birdie-birdie on holes 16-18?

Wilkinson: "Sixteen, hit it down the fairway, hit it to 10 feet, made it. Seventeen, hit it to 3 feet with a 7-iron. Then 18, hit my tee shot in the left rough, then laid up in the right rough. Hit up there to 15 feet and made it. The putter helped me out a little bit.

Q. A guy from Mississippi is probably used to stifling heat and humidity?

Wilkinson: Super standard. I thought I was coming up here [to the Northeast] to get away from this humidity and [heat]. It's not nearly as bad as it is back home right now. It's like 102 with 100 percent humidity. It's brutal."

Q. Is this your first Mid-Am?

Wilkinson: "It is. Youngest player in the field. Turned 25 [on July 25].

Q. Nice way to start in this event?

Wilkinson: "I like it. Everybody is 25, 30, 35 and older guys. I like that. They're not taking it too serious like kids in the U.S. Am. Everybody is laid back and having fun."

Q. Has to be challenging balancing law school and competitive golf?

Wilkinson: "You wouldn't believe how hard it is to take a week off of class to come up here. [My instructors] are great."
