Q. You had a long day today?

Jimmy Castles: "We started at eight at Sleepy [Hollow] and I had to restart from the fescue left [of the fairway]. Then hacked it back up. Basically played 10¼ holes this morning. We were really excited to get back out in the afternoon [at Fenway]."

Q. Is that easier to do rather than finish one day and then have a whole day off from golf?

Jimmy Castles: "I think it's always up to how you internalize it. If you're playing well, you want to keep it going. If that's is your MO (modus operandi) and you want to keep the peddle down. When you have some weather delays, you have to take what is given to you. We tried to do that today. I definitely got off to a slow start this morning, but bounced back nicely."

Q. You got it going a little bit at Fenway in the afternoon?

Jimmy Castles: "The greens break a little different. We started picking our lines and we felt like we had a good line on a few of our wedges. We had to take some spin off with the greens being a little soft. We just tried to keep the momentum down and hopefully get in as many holes as we could of and we were very fortunate and gracious to finish it up."

Q. You obviously will have a long wait on Monday to play your first match?

Jimmy Castles: "I will definitely watch a little [Sunday night] football and sleep a little bit. And put in some good work on the range [on Monday at Sleepy Hollow]. We'll take what is given to us."
