Rianne Malixi: Yeah, number 2 yeah. It was a difficult chip for me, I left it short and then just two putted. Then on 8 I 3-putted on that one.

Rianne Malixi: Yeah.

Q: And I know obviously you want to win every event you tee it up at, that's part of being a golfer, but what is it about this event you enjoy so much because obviously you win last year and now you're probably gonna have a chance to share medalist honors this year, so what do you enjoy so much about this competition?

Rianne Malixi: I mean, I've been playing this event since I was like 14, so I've always loved to come back to this event, see some familiar faces and what I really look forward to this week is really the match play set up. I think it really suits well with my game and that's what I've been really looking forward to these kind of events.

Q: What have you come to really enjoy about this course now that you've got

got a couple of rounds underneath your belt?

Rianne Malixi: Yeah, I'm very lucky to have my coach on the bag. He's played this course a couple of times out here, he knows where to miss it and where to place it and just this course is just really about placement. It can be really pin- irrelevant this week. And then, yeah, I think just really hitting targets all week long will definitely help.

Q: How about your pairing? You got paired with two other Girls' Junior champions, including the one girl that beat you a couple of years ago. Was that fun? Was that a-did you guys talk a lot out there?

Rianne Malixi: I mean, I'm very honored to play with them and it is a really good group, and yeah, I've talked to Kiara and Aphrodite a bit. You know my coach is the one really carrying the conversation all day, he pulled out a couple of dad jokes today and made it really interesting, so yeah.
