

VILLAGE OF PINEHURST, N.C. (July 13, 2021) – The United States Golf Association (USGA) today announced tee times for the first two rounds of the 73rd U.S. Junior Amateur Championship, Monday (July 19) and Tuesday (July 20), at 7,301-yard, par-72 The Country Club of North Carolina (Dogwood Course) and at 7,210-yard, par-71 The Country Club of North Carolina (Cardinal Course), in Village of Pinehurst, N.C.

The U.S. Junior Amateur consists of 36 holes of stroke play on July 19 and 20, after which the 264-player field will be reduced to the low 64 scorers. There will be six rounds of match play, starting July 21. The quarterfinals and semifinals are slated for Friday, July 23. The championship is scheduled to conclude with a 36-hole final on Saturday, July 24, starting at 8 a.m. EDT. The U.S. Junior Amateur champion receives a full exemption into the 2022 U.S. Open Championship.
